Sexual Immorality Is a Serious Matter

Deuteronomy 22:13-30 by Christian Sanich, 1/19/2025

There may be Q&A at the end as time allows. So note your questions.

Sex is intended by God to take place inside marriage only. Going outside of that design should be serious to God's people.

22:13-21 If a new wife is found a virgin or not

Not having sex until one got married was very important, and still is. (see 1 Corinthians 7:1-2) There was honor for her family surrounding the girl's virginity.

Three sources of regulation for us:

- The government (see Romans 13:1-4)
- Self-regulation (see 1 Corinthians 6:9-11)
- The church, Christians to Christians (Matthew 18:15-17)

22:22 Adultery

In Jesus, we have forgiveness of sins, but, He wants His people to stop sinning. (ref.: John 8:3-11)

22:23-24 Sex before marriage, one is betrothed to someone else

Since sex is only supposed to happen in marriage, someone's first sexual experience is something that belongs to a single person's future spouse.

22:25-27 Rape

22:28-29 Sex before marriage

There are a few differences between this and the previous scenario that make it unlikely it was rape. She may have been consenting, or at least giving in. (see Exodus 22:16)

Single people shouldn't engage in sex casually. They should think of sex as an act that is binding them, which is intended to bind a married couple.

The man seems primarily responsible, maybe as the initiator, or maybe it's because He's supposed to be the leader.

22:30 No sex with your father's wife (ref.: 1 Corinthians 5)

God's people should abstain from sexual immorality - any kind of sex outside God's design. (ref.: 1 Thessalonians 4:3)

Save sex for marriage.

Give sex to one another in marriage. (see 1 Cor. 7:3, Prov. 5:18-19) **Keep sex inside marriage, no adultery.**
