<u>Canned goods</u>: stew, chili, pastas with meat, sweet potatoes, tomatoes, beans, fruit, pasta sauce, and evaporated milk

<u>Boxed goods</u>: pasta, milk, stuffing, Jell-o pudding or gelatin, oatmeal, saltine or graham crackers, cake and biscuit/muffin mixes

Other items: peanut butter, jelly, applesauce cups, fruit cups, beans, rice, olive or canola oil

Place your donated items in the Food Pantry collection bin located in the patio area on Sunday mornings. You may also give a monetary donation above and beyond your regular giving. Make sure to mark "Food Pantry" on your envelope or check memo line. Please check the expiration date on your donated items. We are not able to hand out expired food. Every donation helps.
