## Application questions for 5-18-2014 sermon Matthew 6:28-7:9

Seeing Jesus shining in glory, like verse 2 portrays, what do you think that helped the disciples figure out about Jesus?

Is this event significant to you, even though you couldn't be there?

We may not be as familiar as those Jews would have been with all the Old Testament background that would have helped them interpret this event, but do you feel like you understand it now?

What have you come to understand?

(Reminder of some of the things that happened: Moses and Elijah appeared with Jesus. God the Father spoke from a shining cloud, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with Whom I'm well pleased. Listen to Him.")

What authority does this give Jesus in our lives?

Bonus:

Did you also know that what we have in the New Testament letters to churches is largely the Apostles having taken Jesus' teachings and applied them to situations in the early church?

How do you see that as connected to what we learned in this week's passage?
