Woe for closing the kingdom & making people sons of hell (13-15)

The Pharisees taught people salvation by Law and rule keeping.

We should teach people salvation by grace through faith in Jesus.

Woe for guiding people spiritually with foolish logic (16-22)

(ref.: Matthew 5:37)

Don't give guidance like them, & don't listen to teaching like that.

Woe for majoring on the minors, and neglecting the majors (23-24)

Let's not be like the Pharisees.

Are you missing something major, based on God's word?
