Ezek. 45:18-19 Cleansing the temple with blood

“Cleanse” or “purify” means to free from sin.

Sin is disobeying God.

Ezek. 45:20 Making atonement for the people

“Atonement” refers to making amends with God, for sin.

The blood of a sacrifice would make those amends.

Hebrews 9:22, “Without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.”

The sacrifice of Jesus, and His blood, provides forgiveness for our sin

Ezek. 45:20 Atonement is for those who go astray and the naive.

Whether we know God’s word or don’t know God’s word, all of us have sinned against God.

Rom. 3:23, “**All** have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin.

And people are made right with God when they

believe that Jesus sacrificed His life, shedding His blood.

(see Romans 3:25)
