Don't believe that Christ has shown up at any location (vv. 23-26)

Only a false Christ is “here” or “there”.

The goal of the false is to lead astray.

False signs and wonders

(ref.: 2 Thessalonians 2:9)

We shouldn't be lead astray; we have been told beforehand.

Don't go looking for Christ in some earthly location.

The unmistakable coming of the real Christ (vv. 27-28)

Worldwide visibility, across the sky - obvious

He will find you if you are a child of God in Jesus.

(ref.: Luke 17:34-37)
