3:16 All scripture is God-breathed

3:16 The Bible is for learning to live right in the sight of God

3:17 In order that the person of God may be capable –

having been thoroughly equipped – for every good work

3:16 The Bible is what should be used to equip us for right living

These work together to help us make the changes we need, for us to live right in the sight of God.

1 & 2 Thessalonians, or Ephesians x2


Ask for a book mark

Application questions for 11-15-2015 sermon
2 Timothy 3:16-17

What do you presently look for in Christian teaching you listen to? Does that need to change, in light of what you heard in the sermon?
