**3:1 Christians, think carefully about Jesus.**

The High Priest

The Apostle

We should listen carefully to the truth Jesus brought.

**3:2 Jesus was as faithful in His assignment from God as Moses.**

**3:3-6a Jesus is worthy of more honor/glory than Moses.**

Moses was part of the house, whereas Jesus is the builder.

Jesus is the builder and owner of the church.

He is our top leader and deserves the glory.

Moses was a servant of God in the house,  
whereas Jesus is the Son of God over the house.

What Moses said was just preparation for what Jesus would say and do.

We should pay more attention to Jesus.

Are you reading His words of life?

Are you talking to Him and listening?

**Pride** (ref.: Mark 8:38)

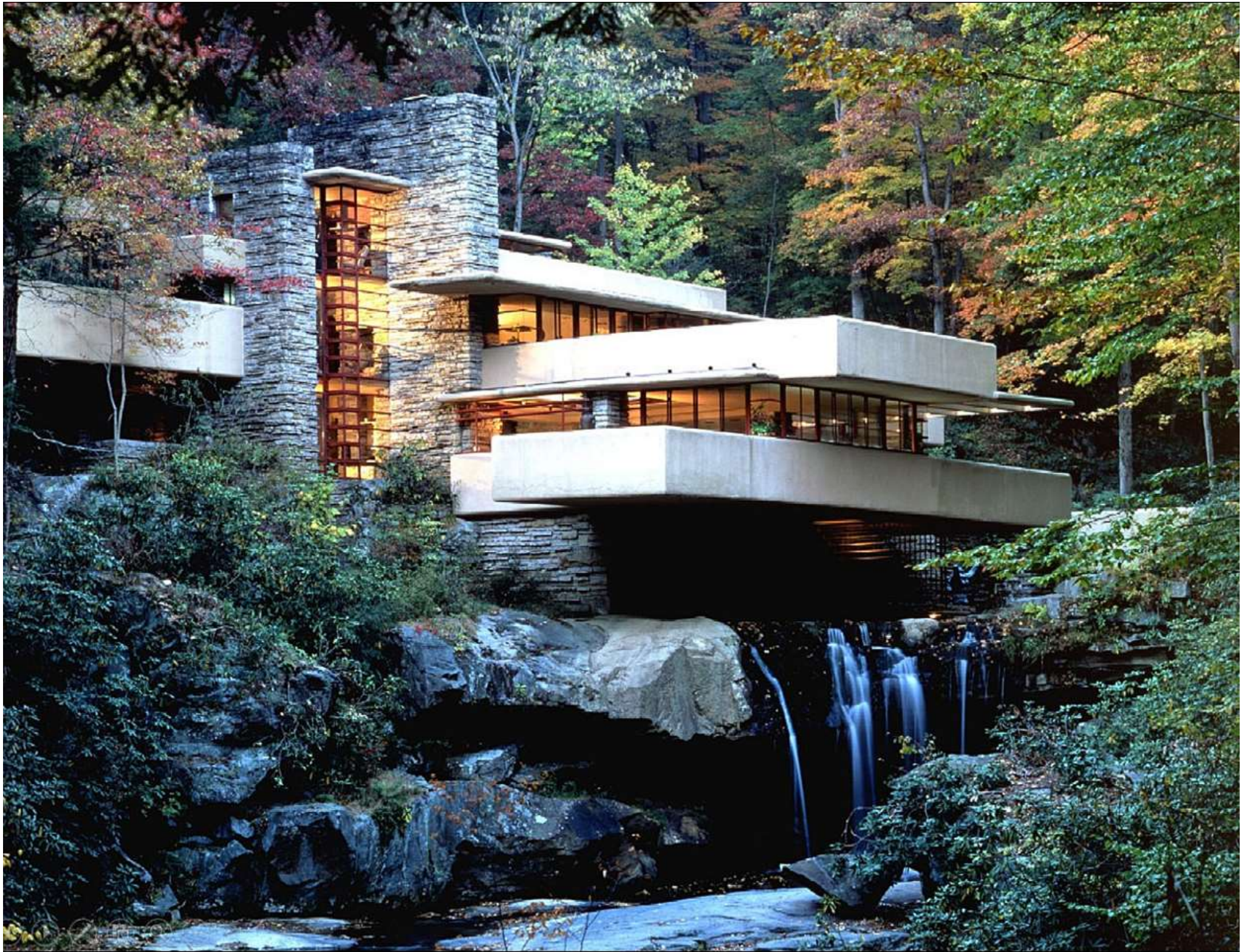

Have you learned anything about Jesus during this Hebrews study that is causing you to think about Him in a new way? If not, is there anything you have been reminded of about Jesus that has been significant to you?

Is it helping you think more about Him during the week?

On the note of taking Jesus' leadership and listening to Him about life:

Are you regularly seeking His teaching (like reading the Bible)?
