6:9 Choosing behaviors that accompany salvation

We are created in Christ Jesus for good works.

(Ref.: Ephesians 2:8-10)

6:10a God does not ignore our works.

**God will reward Christians for their works,
and take away rewards for not doing those works.**

(ref.: 2 Corinthians 5:8-10;
also see 1 Corinthians 3:14-15)

6:10b Loving is doing actions that are good to/for people.

(ref.: Mark 12:28-31)

Serving Christians is loving them and God.

When we serve Christ's people, His church,
we are showing love to Christ Himself.

(Ref.: Matthew 25:31-40)

You don't have to have feelings or even know the
people to love them by serving.
