Review of 1 Peter 1:3-6

**1:6-7 You'll show your faith to yourself when you rejoice in trials.**

Even in the middle of the worst trial, whatever it may be, "you should rejoice."

If you face distressing trials in life, and through it you rejoice because of what you have in Christ, it provides you with "proof of your faith."

This proof of faith is precious.

The kind of faith that rejoices in trials will result in your praise, glory, and honor when Jesus comes again.

**1:8a Show love for Jesus.**

Come to love Him similar to how you came to have faith in Him.

Spend time with Christians talking deeply about Jesus.

Get to know Jesus from the Bible.

Spend time with Jesus, in prayer.

Do you love Him? Are you doing those things?

**1:8b Show your passion for Jesus that is on the inside, by glorifying Him with outward expression.**

Glorifying Jesus refers to speaking of His magnificence, and implies you can improve the way people think of Him.

Are you trying to be a private Christian?

**1:9 The outcome of your faith will be the salvation of your soul.**

## **Show What Is In You**

(Try to have everyone answer this question.)

What is something that in the last couple months you have said you wanted to work on, and how are you doing with that?

The topics of this week can be difficult to be honest with in a group about, but trust the group that they care for you and being honest is the best for you to progress.

Do you ever doubt that your faith in Christ is real? Why do you think that is, and what does it feel like?

What would it mean to you to have confidence that your faith is real?

What did you learn from this week's passage/sermon about how you can get that confidence, proof of your faith?

Do you love Jesus? What is your relationship with Him like?

If you love Him, how would you say you got to that point?

**(Make sure to make it to this question, and try to have everyone answer.)**

Would you like to love Jesus, or love Him more? What can you do right away to start moving toward that, and do you plan to do that?

Are you trying to be a private Christian? If so, why do you think that is? If not, do you think people see your passion for Jesus, and how do they see that?

Do you have a question for the group? It might be something you don't understand that others could help with, or something you think should be covered that hasn't.

Was there anything new or interesting you learned in this sermon?
