What We Have In Christ Is Worth Further Study

1 Peter 1:10-12

Review of the context:

1:10 The O.T. prophets searched intently and investigated carefully about the grace that would come to you, and now has.

They gave great time, effort, and attention, trying to learn.

1:11 The O.T. prophets investigated who or what time the Spirit was indicating, foretelling the sufferings of Christ and the glories to follow.

Who = Christ What time = after the prophets' time

The Spirit made known to the prophets and they wrote it down.

Are you fascinated enough by the subject of your own salvation?

1:12a The prophets weren't even serving themselves, yet they investigated carefully these things we now have.

We have the good news of salvation by grace, prophesied in the O.T., recorded by the apostles in the N.T.

How interested are you in it?

How much time do you spend reading the Bible, thinking deeply about it, and meditating on it in prayer?

1:12b The angels have strong desire to look closely, intellectually, at our salvation by grace, through faith in Christ.

Do you want to continue to look at it closely, intellectually?

Continuing to study the Bible is for every level of knowledge and maturity.

What is your response to this? Discuss it with someone today.

Suggested related reading: The Bible is inspired and profitable for us, 2 Timothy 3:16-17; the word of God is alive to us, Hebrews 4:12; move on to maturity with the word, Hebrews 5:12-6:2
