12:15 **A fool always thinks his way is right, but the wise listens to counsel.**

15:22 **Counsel helps you succeed, instead of fail.**

11:14 **In an abundance of counselors there is victory.**

Why do we seek counsel on less important things, and not on how to live life, and making important life decisions?

10:17 **If you want to do life well, then heed instruction, and accept reproof (correction).**

15:31-32 **Instruction and reproof help your life. So ignoring those is like hating yourself.**

15:12 **A fool hates reproof and won't go to the wise for wisdom. He may even mock those who reprove him.**

12:1 **He who hates reproof is stupid.**

29:1 **A person who keeps rejecting reproof gets hardened, and when he finally breaks, he may be beyond remedy.**

27:6 **Faithful are the wounds of a friend.**

True friends should help you be better, even if it hurts a bit.

27:17 **Iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another.**
