The Spirit Reveals Jesus & His Word

John 14:15-26

This is how we are to live in an ongoing, loving, relationship with Jesus Christ, in which we are aware of Him, and following His teaching.

14:15 One way we engage in relationship with Jesus is we love Him.

This love, *agape* love, is demonstrated by actions.

Jesus says, "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments."

14:16-17 Jesus asks the Father to send the Helper, the Spirit of truth, who will dwell in those who trust and love Jesus.

The Holy Spirit is now God's representative here on earth. He is the special presence of God to us.

Now, as soon as someone trusts Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit comes to live in them. (John 7:39, Galatians 3:2-14)

The Holy Spirit comes to live in us when we trust Jesus Christ.

Born again by the Spirit (John 3:3-7)

Regenerated by the Holy Spirit (Titus 3:5)

Baptized into one body by the Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:13)

Sealed in Christ with the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 1:13-14)

The temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:19)

14:18-19 The Holy Spirit's presence is how we perceive Jesus.

14:20-21 We are to have a loving relationship with God - loving Jesus, loved by the Father and Jesus, perceiving it through the Spirit.

14:22-24a Jesus loves, lives with, and discloses Himself to those who love Him, and not to those who don't love and trust Him.

Again, loving Him is demonstrated by keeping His word.

14:24b-26 The Holy Spirit now continues Jesus' teaching ministry.
