## **I Should Not Call Any Person Unclean;**

### **Jesus is for All People**

Acts 10:1-11:18

10:1-8 **An angel directed Cornelius, a Gentile, to Peter.**

God can get the message of Jesus to anyone.

10:9-23 **The Lord gave Peter a vision of unclean creatures and declared them no longer unclean, then sent him to the Gentiles.**

Based on this example, it appears that the Holy Spirit may lead us when and to whom He wants us to testify about Jesus.

10:24-35 **Peter understood the Lord's message that we should not call any person unclean, so he came to those Gentiles.**

We know that our closest relationships are not supposed to be with non-Christians (see 2 Cor. 6:14-18). But, we need to associate with non-Christians, to be able to share the gospel of Christ with them.

10:34-43 **Peter shared the basics of the gospel with them.**

- Jesus' life on earth showed He was from God
- Jesus died on a cross (to provide forgiveness of sins)
- Jesus rose from the dead
- Jesus is the judge of all
- Everyone who trusts in Jesus receives forgiveness of sins

You can share that with non-Christians.

10:44-48 **The Holy Spirit came upon the newly believing Gentiles, and they were baptized in the name of Jesus Christ.**

The Holy Spirit confirmed that Christ was for them.

Their water baptism confirmed they were in Christ and the church.

11:1-18 **Other Christians came to understand the same as Peter.**

(ref.: 1 Corinthians 12:13)
