Acts 12:1-24

Text sermon questions, during the sermon, to (602) 824-8030

12:1-5 Herod had James killed and put Peter in prison.

While Peter was in prison, prayers for him were being made fervently (continually) by the church to God.

12:6-17 An angel of the Lord broke Peter out of prison, and Peter showed up at the prayer meeting happening for him.

“The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.” (James 5:16b)

12:18-23 An angel of the Lord killed Herod for stealing God’s glory.

12:24 Despite attacks on the church, the word of the Lord continued to grow and be multiplied.

Is there some new prayer habit you want to start, or get back to?
