20:1-6 Paul revisited churches to strengthen Christians with exhortation.

20:7-12 Paul instructed a kid to death.

Eutychus being brought back to life, at Easter season, is a reminder of Jesus' resurrection power.

20:13-16 Paul traveled by land as his companions went by sea.

20:17-27 Ways Paul followed the course the Lord had given him

Paul served the Lord with all humility.

Paul did not shrink from declaring anything that was beneficial.

Paul was committed to doing what the Holy Spirit lead him to do.

20:36-38 The elders affectionately said goodbye to Paul.
