3:1-4 Being fleshly as apposed to spiritual

They weren't just struggling with giving in to sinful desires; rather, they weren't even trying to live God's ways.

There was jealousy and strife in them.

When problems display themselves outwardly in our relationships, it's because we have problems inside of us.

What behaviors keep displaying themselves in your life, that you know are not what God wants? Behind that wrong behavior, what desire is in you? What wrong attitude is in you?

3:5-9 The Lord is the one growing people, and we are all equally servants, who are supposed to work with Him, toward His goals.

Does the way that you think about Christian teachers or leaders need to change, based on the perspective we have learned today?

Now, think about yourself as a servant in Christ's church.

How are you doing being a faithful servant of the Lord, at whatever task He has assigned you?

What is your response to this? Discuss it with someone today.
