You Must Flee Sexual Immorality Indeed, You Must Glorify God in Your Body

1 Corinthians 6:12-20 by Christian Sanich, 1/12/2020

6:12 You may be free to do it, but not all things are beneficial, and we should not be mastered by anything (except the Lord).

Sexual immorality is not beneficial. It has many devastating consequences.

6:13-14 The body is not for sexual immorality, but for the Lord. God is even going to raise our bodies up.

Our bodies matter to the Lord.

Suggested related reading: Romans 12:1-2

6:15-17 In sexual immorality you take what belongs to Christ, your body, and inappropriately join it to another through sex. May it never be! We are joined to the Lord.

Not only do our bodies belong to Christ, we represent Christ here on earth, including what we do with our bodies.

Sexual immorality is being unfaithful to the Lord.

Giving ourselves to sexual immorality should be unthinkable.

Our bodies belong to the Lord.

6:18-20 You must flee sexual immorality. It is sin agains one's own body. Your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. And you are not your own. For you were bought with Christ's death. Indeed, you must glorify God in your body.

God has taken possession of us.

Sexual immorality is danger. We need to get away, right away.
