Philippians 2:1-4

2:1 Motivation, to prepare us for the exhortation

2:2 Exhortation - to be united in attitude

Have the same attitude toward the church as Christ had.

Maintain the same love for one another as Christ had for us
(1 John 4:11, 4:19, John 13:34)

Holding one attitude in full accord (joined together in soul)

2:3 The attitude

Nothing from selfishness or self-importance

But rather, with humility - not thinking I'm most important

Regard one another as more important than self.

2:4 How we will behave if we have the attitude

Look out for the interests of others.

“look out” = to notice, to be concerned about, to give careful attention to

Some ideas:

Is there something I want to do?

Regarding my attitude and behavior related to coronavirus, is there something I should think or do differently?

What is your response to this? Discuss it with someone today.

Suggested memorization: Philippians 2:3, or 2:4, or both
