Each Christian is an Important Part of the Body

1 Corinthians 12:12-26

12:12-14 **The one body of Christ has many, equal members.**

We show Christ when we function properly as the church.

The Holy Spirit made us each part of the one body of Christ.

Baptism of the Holy Spirit is not a second experience for a Christian; rather, it is one of the first, making us part of the body of Christ.

12:15-17 **Those who feel like unimportant body parts, are wrong.**

The church functions optimally when every single part does its part, serving.

12:18-20 **God has set it up so that the one body is made up of many members, of which each has a function.**

God wants each Christian, involved in serving the church, because each is part of the body of Christ.

12:21-26 **There should be no divisions in the body; but rather, we should have concern for one another, and honor one another.**

What is your response to this? Discuss it with someone today.

Telling servants, “Good job”, and, “I appreciate you”

Coming in line with God, by seeing Christians differently than the world sees people.

If somebody is left out, feeling unimportant, discouraged, care for them, sympathize, and try to make it right.
