## **Behavior Follows Beliefs**

1 Corinthians 15:29-34 by Christian Sanich, 12/6/2020

15:29 The people who were being baptized for the dead, showed by their behavior that they believed in the resurrection.

15:30-32 Paul did some extreme stuff that reflected His strong belief in the resurrection.

Paul lived this life in a sacrificial manner, for the sake of serving Christ and for the sake of people coming to trust Christ.

The Corinthians were evidence of that.

Paul's ministry in Ephesus was another example of him being willing to sacrifice in this life to bring the gospel to others.

Paul was doing these things trusting in God, who raises the dead.

If the dead are not raised, then just enjoy yourself now.

15:33-34 If you hang out with and listen to the wrong people, it will start to influence your beliefs, which will in turn influence your behavior, in a bad way.

Is there any bad company you keep, and have discussion with, that might negatively influence you?

Is there any bad teaching you listen to?

You should not continue to sin.

You may have to root out the wrong beliefs that have been allowing the continuation of sin.

You may have to get away from some bad influences, which have led to the wrong beliefs.

What/who are you living for?

What is your response to this? Discuss it with someone today.
